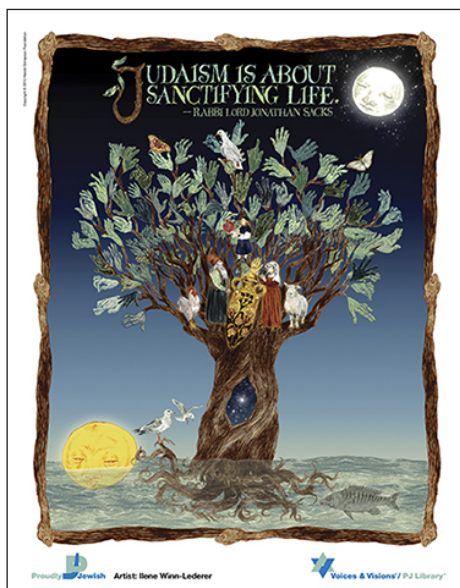
## New Poster Series *Proudly Jewish*

Which is your favorite poster in the series, and why?

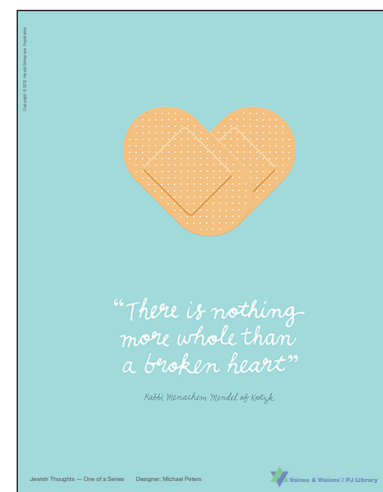
